

The Ioan Davies Award

MA and PhD students in the Joint Graduate Program in Communication and Culture at York University are invited to apply for the Ioan Davies Award. This award is given annually to an outstanding student or students in the Graduate Program in Communication and Culture who is in financial need and has demonstrated an interest in the topics reflected in the work of Ioan Davies:

- aesthetics;
- critical cultural theory;
- culture in the global arena;
- culture in everyday life;
- technology and identity; and
- the culture of cities.

Professor Davies, who taught at York from 1972 until his death in 2000, helped establish the African Studies Program, the Graduate Program in Social and Political Thought and the Joint Graduate Program in Communication and Culture, and was a founder of the journal *border/lines*. Students may be nominated by faculty, or may apply independently.

The nomination, or application, *must include the application form, statement of research and how your research interests coincide with those of Prof. Davies, a budget and the submission of a completed seminar paper or chapter from a thesis or dissertation.*

Applicants' year of study and degree requirements will be taken into consideration in the adjudication of this award. This year's award will be granted at the annual Ioan Davies Memorial Lecture on (tentatively) Thursday, 13 October 2016. We will be awarding the scholarship recipient at this event and hope that you will be able to attend. Depending upon the number and strength of the applications, there may be two awards.

Award amount: Up to \$2,000 (or if two awards are made up to \$1,000 each).

Eligibility: MA and PhD students registered full-time at York University in the Joint Graduate Program in Communication and Culture. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or permanent residents, and an Ontario resident.

REVISED DEADLINE - for submission is 12:30 pm on 15 August 2016.

Please make sure you have everything ready to upload before completing the form as you cannot save it and go back to it. You will need: Statement of research interests and how they coincide with Prof. Davies interests (1 page); budget (1 page); seminar paper or chapter. Please do *not* make multiple applications in order to upload additional documents.
